- 50% of Year 3 and Year 5 students achieving in the top two bands in the Reading and Writing strands, 2019 NAPLAN Tests.

Our initiatives include

- Build capability and collective efficacy in English through working with our Executive Coach.
- Provide focussed and intensive teaching in English for students to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards.
- Build teacher knowledge in the productive mode and creative thinking skills of Australian Curriculum – English.
- Complete an Australian Curriculum-informed and evidenced-based Writing Framework.

Employ a teacher aide to deliver the Level Literacy Intervention system.	\$930
Employ TRS to release teachers each term, to interrogate reading and writing data and discuss the case management of students at risk of not attaining National Minimum Standard in Reading and Writing.	\$1,138
Employ an Executive Coach to build capacity of teachers to implement the Australian Curriculum – English achievement standards across multi-age classes and support teachers in data gathering, collation, analysis and use.	\$27,159
