Our initiatives include

- Engaging an Inclusion Teacher to support a whole school approach towards inclusion including social-emotional/ well-being development, case management and targeted teaching/ co-teaching;
- Contextualised professional learning for non-teaching staff in inclusive practices;
- Planned opportunities to release classroom teachers to deepen knowledge of the Australian Curriculum in a multi-age setting, (focus on aspects of the achievement standards and assessment alignment);
- Differentiated teaching and learning through data conversations and the four stages of moderation.
